Notification of On-campus Requirements

Medina Valley ISD with guidance from TEA has determined certain Career and Technical (CTE) classes require a portion of the course to be completed on-campus. These courses require specialized equipment, direct supervision of hands-on activities, and/or specific materials and technology. The appropriate amount of on-campus instruction needed to meet the TEKS and award course credit will vary by course.

Students choosing remote instruction may be required to come on campus to carry out specified assignments and activities that cannot be reasonably completed remotely. This notification ensures students have an option to select courses that can be completed remotely if desired. Families may choose different electives that can be satisfied in a fully remote setting.

Students and Parents will be contacted by the course instructor with a complete list of assignments and activities requiring completion on-campus no later than the week prior to the start of each six weeks of instruction. Students and parents will work directly with the instructor to schedule on-campus instruction dates and times to ensure the safety of the student.

*NOTE:* During the 1st 6 weeks activities or assignments that can not be completed remotely will not be required.
