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What will G/T services look like remotely?

- Differentiation will be consistently embedded within the students regularly scheduled content classes through the use of enrichment activities, learning menus, choice boards, virtual field trips, videos, and podcasts. G/T Specialists will oversee and support all lessons to ensure fidelity and meaningfulness of remote learning.
- K-2 grade will utilize the SeeSaw platform and 3-12 grades will utilize Google Classroom as the delivery method. Organization within these systems provides the opportunity to communicate announcements, assignments, and ongoing collaboration among students and G/T District Specialists.
- Regularly scheduled video chats shall be hosted through Google Meets to allow students the opportunity to collaborate with the classroom setting and work closely with G/T Specialists and highly-qualified G/T teachers.
- Opportunities will be provided for students to create advanced-level products in the remote setting.
- Secondary students will still be encouraged to challenge themselves through Pre-AP, AP, and Dual Credit course offerings. Counselors will be working with Specialists to encourage and support students on their academic and postsecondary choices.
