A PowerPoint Presentation by Kevin Ficke, Tx-DFPS Special Investigations gave an informative presentation on Human Trafficking and how it relates to our youth. He recommended that parents be involved with their children and be aware of the Social Media Platforms that are currently popular with those looking to exploit children and teenagers. He recommended viewing a YouTube video called "Be the One". He said the video profiles how and why children and teenagers are getting involved in these situations. Officer Ficke states that he and others in his department are taught how to talk to and what signs to look for in these young people that would indicate underlying problems. The young person may then reveal information that may have not been mentioned. Many compliments were given about Officer Ficke's presentation and we hope to have him back again in the future.

Topics tabled for the next SHAC meeting are the Approval of Parent Co-Chair and Secretary and the report on Campus Wellness from our District's Coaches, Nurses, and Personnel from the Food Services.
