6. Supervise the amount of time my child spends watching television, playing video games, and ensure that I MONITOR the QUALITY of programs.

8. Monitor academic progress by checking progress reports or e-school plus/Home Access Center.
9. Attend school functions and activities. (Join PTO) Encourage my child to utilize district approved Programs.
